

Year 3 - In Term 4, we will be learning to...

English

Students will be exploring poetry. They will read a poem, based on a familiar setting, and write and present a variation of this poem.

Mathematics

Students will be continuing to learn about multiplication. Students will investigate fractions (halves, quarters and thirds), mapping, symmetry, three-dimensional objects and angles in real situations.

Science

Students will be investigating the changing state of liquids and solids when heat is added or removed. They will make a prediction, record observations and suggest reasons for findings.

HASS

Students will be continuing to explore democracy, including how decisions are made within our Australian government and how rules are made.

Technology

Students will be completing an assessment using Microsoft EXCEL to display data that they collect, and then use the data to decide on an environmental problem.

Dance

Students will be working in a group to perform, create and respond to a dance that they or others perform.

Health

Students will be investigating emotions and positive interactions.

PE

Students will participate in swimming lessons at our school pool. The lessons will be conducted by Mrs Betts and supported by Mrs Toy and Mrs Byrne, who are all qualified AUSTSWIM instructors. Year 3 students will perform aquatic skills such as safe entries and exits, treading water, floating, submergence, survival strokes and the recognised swimming strokes of freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly.

Music

Students are performing, composing and responding to music that portrays characters and action. They are collaborating to compose a short piece of music that represents a character of their choosing.
