 - improve the number of students achieving C or higher in English from 87% (2021) to 90% and A or B results from 45% (2021) to 50% (2022);
 - identify, through NCCD, at-risk students and improve their engagement within the school context and the curriculum.
- Strengthen the implementation of the Calliope State School Student Learning and Wellbeing Framework and the Student Code of Conduct with integrity.
