MATHS

We are working on data and probability. We are constantly bombarded with data in the media, and it is important for us to think critically about what it is showing us. We learn about mean, median and mode averages & decide whether a dice game has fair outcomes.

SCIENCE

In this biology unit, we will be conducting field studies and fair testing experiments to learn all about how living things affect and are affected by their environment. We'll also take a look at how plants and animals are classified, and the process of adaptation.

ENGLISH

We will be exploring the rights of animal through a literary and informative texts. Each of these texts is trying to persuade the reader of a particular point of view, and have a different approach to persuasion. We will compare and analyse these texts to choose which one is more effective in persuading an audience.

DRAMA
